THE 22th ANNUAL HAMPTONS INTERNATIONAL FILM FESTIVAL

East Hampton, NY (October 14th, 2013) – The Hamptons International Film Festival today announced their audience award winners from East Hampton. THE IMITATION GAME and IRIS were honored with the Audience Awards for Narrative and Documentary, respectively. FEAST won the Audience Award for Best Short Film.

THE IMITATION GAME was also the winner of the Alfred P. Sloan Feature Film Award at this year's Festival, which just wrapped and ran from October 9th through October 13th. The Festival played over 129 films from around the world.
